Pre-Anesthetic Blood Testing:

Like you, our greatest concern is the well being of your pet. Before putting your pet under anesthesia, we will perform a physical examination. However, many conditions, including disorders of the liver, kidneys and blood, may not be detected unless blood testing is performed. Such tests are especially important before anesthesia.

For these reasons, we strongly recommend that all patients receive a blood screen before such procedures. The total cost of these important tests is \$72.69.

Pain Management:

Research has indicated that while pets may appear to withstand pain better than humans do, they still experience pain to a great degree. While undergoing surgery, your pet will receive anesthetic drugs that prevent pain. However, additional medications have recently become available that now enable us to safely and effectively control the level of your pet's discomfort after surgery. For non-routine surgery pain meds can be included at an additional cost.

Electrocardiogram (EKG):

Used to detect heart arrhythmias. Especially important to detect heart problems before anesthesia.

Note: Dogs presented for spaying, if pregnant or recently in heat, will be charged an additional fee. Cats presented for spaying, while pregnant will be charged an additional fee. All pets must be current on vaccines or else they will be given before the pet has surgery. These vaccines must be administered by a licensed veterinarian. The owner must provide proof of vaccines prior to surgery. The declaw patients will be hospitalized for 2 nights after the surgery, and can be discharged after 10 a.m. on the second day. Our staff does not remain on the premises after closing. All animals must be free of internal and external parasites. IF INTERNAL OR EXTERNAL PARASITES ARE PRESENT, THEY WILL BE TREATED AT OWNER'S EXPENSE.
