

**WHAT IS NEEDED FOR YOUR PET TO STAY AT
ATASCAZOO ANIMAL HOSPITAL...**

All pets that will be staying at Atascazoo Animal Hospital for boarding, day stay, anesthesia or elective procedures are required to be current on vaccinations (listed below), an intestinal parasite test (with no parasites found), and a yearly exam before being admitted to the hospital. This is for the health and safety of your pet, the other pets staying here at the hospital, and the Atascazoo staff.

If your pet was not vaccinated at Atascazoo Animal Hospital, you must provide a copy of your pet's vaccination and labwork history from a licensed veterinarian. **Only vaccines administered by a licensed veterinarian will be accepted.** We do not accept verbal verification over the phone. Please bring hard copies of the vaccine and labwork history on or before your pet's stay at Atascazoo Animal Hospital.

Dog requirements:

- Yearly exam,
- Negative intestinal parasite test - within past year,
- Current Rabies, DHPP, Leptospirosis, Bordetella and Influenza vaccines

Cat requirements:

- Yearly exam,
- Negative intestinal parasite test – within past year,
- Current Rabies and FRCP vaccines

All animals must be free of internal and external parasites (including fleas). Parasites will be treated at the owner's expense.

Vaccinations are most effective 14 days after being administered. Please try to have your pet's vaccinations administered at least 2 weeks prior to any boarding, day stay, anesthesia or elective procedures. Our staff will be happy to assist you with timing these appointments appropriately.
